IMPORTANT – Fundraising reminder:

All State Team Sponsorship Raffle ticket stubs must be returned to Volleyball Victoria, 270 Stud Rd, Dandenong North, 3175, **strictly by Tuesday 1st June, 2010.** You can return the ticket stubs in person at the State Volleyball Centre on Monday or Tuesday if you don't hand them in at training on 30th May, or they can be sent in the post (sending them express post on Monday will ensure they reach the office in time).

All **PBA Water Fundraiser Order Forms are due strictly by Sunday 6th June.** Volleyball Victoria will order all water for all athletes on Monday 7th June – no late orders can be accepted after Sunday 6th June. Water can be collected on Sunday 20th June, for you to deliver to your purchasers.

You may be contacted about an outstanding fee that you have in fact paid. If a payment is made into the Volleyball Victoria account that does not clearly indicate which athlete/account the payment is for, these payments can only be revisited and reconciled at the end of the month. In the event that you have made a payment that we can't identify, we will need your assistance and further information, receipts or reference numbers, in order to apply the payment to your account.
